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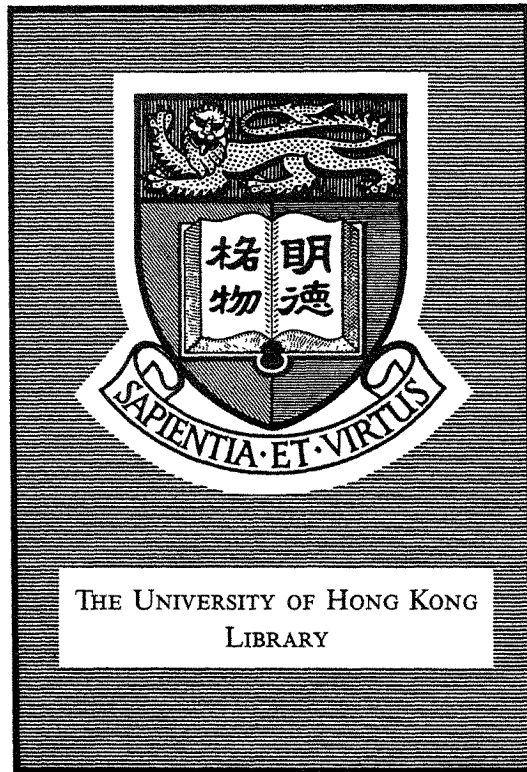

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# **I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**





## **Preamble**

The Careers Education and Placement Centre conducts annual survey to collect employment information on the first job destinations of the current year's graduates.

More specifically, the objectives of the survey are three-fold :

1. To monitor the placement of graduates in the employment market by establishing
  - i. the employment rate
  - ii. time taken to secure employment
  - iii. employment sector
  - iv. occupation
  - v. salary
  - vi. further studies
  - vii. job - hopping rate
  - viii. satisfaction with job
  - ix. relevance of work to study
2. To facilitate students' job search by offering specific employment information such as the names of employers, job titles etc.
3. To provide guidelines for the Centre in the planning and design of career programmes.

This report is produced to meet the objectives mentioned and contains employment information on 1.i - vii above. Attitudinal information on 1.viii - ix was processed separately and will be available upon request.

## **2 Overview**

1. Employment rate remains high, with most new graduates securing employment by the month of September. Commerce and Industry continues to be the major employment destination with the largest number becoming Marketing Executives within this sector. Education and the Civil Service employed 17.7% and 9.4% of new graduates respectively. Basic median monthly salary increased by 4.3%, significantly lower than the recent inflation rate of Hong Kong. Most graduates from professional disciplines entered career fields which were relevant to their subjects of study.
2. The percentage of new graduates pursuing further studies increased by 0.4%. Most of them studied P.C.L.L. (44.6%) and Master of Philosophy (31.5%) which decreased by 4.8% and 1.5% respectively over 1991.
3. The job-hopping rate at 53.7% within 6 months of graduation is still uncomfortably high and the job satisfaction rate of only 75.1% still causes concern.
4. While higher education institutions increase their output, whether or not the high employment rate will continue, has yet to be seen. The Careers Education and Placement Centre has certainly registered the need to prepare students for the competition and to advise them to be realistic in their expectation.

The number of management trainee positions with major employers has dropped by 20% in the last 2 years whereas line functions with medium-sized employers have grown. The numbers of vacancies in the Civil Service and Secondary Schools are not keeping pace with graduate output. New graduates are well-advised to explore employment opportunities with medium-sized employers.

### **I. 3 Key Findings**

1. 16% of the 1992 graduates pursued further studies, and 80.3% secured full-time employment six months after their final examination. In spite of the keen competition for jobs, a lower unemployment rate of 1.8% was recorded as compared with that of 1991 (2.5%). The unemployment rate may fluctuate between 1.8% and 2.7% in the coming two years, subject to the future political and economic situations.
2. Commerce & Industry continued to be the largest employment sector absorbing 68.5% of graduates. It was followed by Education (17.7%), the Civil Service (9.4%) and Community & Social Services (4.4%).
3. A shift in the employment trend towards the private sector was evident from 46.9% in 1983 to 72.9% in 1992. A reverse pattern was observed for the Education sector which had steadily declined from 38.5% to 17.7% in ten years' time.
4. Despite the growing dominance of the Commerce & Industry sector, a significant proportion of the Civil & Structural Engineering (44%) and Surveying graduates (25%) joined the Civil Service, and Education continues to be a major destination for Science (33.7%) and Arts graduates (33.1%). On the other hand, graduates placed in the Community and Social Services sector came mainly from Speech and Hearing (80%) and Social Work (34.8%).
5. While graduates of professional disciplines mostly started their careers in related professions, graduates of general disciplines obtained employment in a wide range of occupations, with Secondary School Teacher, Marketing/Sales Executive, Personnel/Administrative/Management Executive topping the list.
6. An overall 4.3% increase over 1991 was recorded for basic median monthly income (\$8,550) as well as gross median monthly income (\$9,798). Considering the inflation factor, this actually reflected a decline in real income. In 1993, basic monthly income may rise to \$9,585, following previous trends.
7. This year, 16% of the graduates decided to pursue further studies representing a slight increase of 0.4% over 1991. Postgraduate Certificate in Laws accounted for 44.6%, Master of Philosophy for 31.5% and Master by Coursework for 13.4%. Over 90% of these graduates continued their studies in local tertiary institutions.

## **II. GENERAL INFORMATION**



## II. 1 Survey Population

This employment survey covers the 1992 graduates from all full-time Bachelor degrees except the medical graduates, as the 1991 cohort of medical graduates was surveyed instead of the 1992 cohort to reflect their employment situation six months after the one year mandatory internship. ## II. 2 Survey Method

This survey was conducted between early September and end of December 1992. Self-completion questionnaires were mailed to all 1992 graduates. Two reminders were sent to those who did not respond. Before the close of the survey on 31st December, telephone interviews were conducted to verify the status of the unemployed and non-respondents. Among the 1943 graduates surveyed, valid responses were provided by 1817, giving a response rate of 93.5%.

To ensure that the collected data is free from error, completed questionnaires were validated through various stages and doubtful returns have been verified.

## II. 3 Occupational Classification

In addition to the classification system adopted by the Centre, graduates' occupation data was also analyzed by the classification system specified by the University & Polytechnic Grants Committee (UPGC) with summary results presented in the Appendices.

## II. 4 Points to Note

### 4.1 Statistical Analysis

- 4.1.1 The least-squares trend line was used to fit the annual data of the basic monthly salary of HKU graduates in the past nine years and to perform forecasting from 1993 to 1995. The discrepancies between the actual data and the fitted linear model are smaller than 7.6%.
- 4.1.2 The autoregressive model was used to obtain a historical fit of the annual data of the unemployment rate in the past ten years and to perform forecasting of their future behaviour from 1993 to 1995.
- 4.1.3 The statistical model selection was based on residual analysis and the magnitude of the forecasting errors.
- 4.1.4 Past annual data for trend analysis was collected as far back as possible to enhance both accuracy and reliability of the model application.

### 4.2 Definition of Terms

- 4.2.1 "Gross monthly income" includes basic salary, allowances (such as lunch and transport allowance) and commissions, if any, and the total is recalculated on the basis of 12 payments per annum.
- 4.2.2 The following explanatory notes provide clarification on certain occupational classification systems used in this report.
  - (a) Other Teachers/Education Personnel - occupations such as special education teacher and education method advisor, etc.
  - (b) Other Researchers - occupations such as research assistant, research officer, etc.
  - (c) Other Computer Specialists/Personnel - occupations such as software development engineer, EDP manager, computer project officer, etc.
  - (d) Other Related Writers/Journalists - occupations such as news reporter, research writer, translator, etc.
  - (e) Other Miscellaneous Specialists - occupations such as sociologist, speech therapist, anthropologist, psychologist, philologist and related professional and technical worker.
  - (f) Other Government Posts - occupations such as Assistant Information Officer, Environmental Protection Inspector, Technician, etc.
  - (g) Other Engineers - occupations such as safety engineer, assurance engineer, etc.
  - (h) Other Aircraft & Ship Officers - occupations such as flight navigators, aircraft pilots, flight engineers, ship masters, ship pilots, ship engineers, etc.
  - (i) Other Managerial Personnels - occupations such as administrative officer in the Civil Service.

- (j) Other Executives -  
occupations such as resident officer, customer service officer, project executive,  
etc.
- (k) Not Classified -  
occupations not included in the classification lists.

#### 4.3 Note in Reading the Tables

The figures (percentage) in each table have been rounded off to the nearest digit, and may not tally with 100.





### **III. SUMMARY OF FINDINGS**



### III. 1 Employment Situation

#### 1.1 The Overall Situation

This year, 1459 out of the 1817 respondents (80.3%) had secured full-time employment while 291 (16%) decided to pursue further studies. Among the 55 graduates (3.1%) who were still seeking full-time employment, 23 (1.3%) had secured part-time employment and a lower unemployment rate (1.8%) was recorded compared with that in 1991 (2.5%). (chart 1)

#### 1.2 Employment Situation by Curriculum

Overall, graduates from the various degree courses enjoyed a very high rate of employment . Only a few curricula experienced a relatively higher percentage of unemployment/part-time employment at the time of the survey.

#### 1.3 Trend Analysis

Annual data from 1985 - 1992 showed an increased proportion of graduates joining the workforce since 1988. The percentage of graduates pursuing further education remained in the region of 16% since its drop from 19.6% in 1987. (chart 3)

During the past ten years, the annual data of unemployment rate highly correlated with their preceding and successive values, ranging from 1.6% to 3.3%. According to the result of this analysis, the unemployment rate in 1993 may increase to more than 2%. (chart 4)

### III. 2 Employment Sector

#### 2.1 The Overall Situation

Consistent with the previous years, the Commercial sector maintained its dominant position absorbing the majority of graduates (68.5%). It is followed by Education (17.7%), the Civil Service (9.4%) and lastly, Community and Social Services which took only 4.4% of the graduates. (chart 6)

#### 2.2 Employment Sector by Sex

An analysis by sex reveals an interesting difference between male and female graduates. While there was a higher percentage of male graduates joining the Commercial sector (76.4%) as contrasted with their female counterpart (58.1%), the latter was more likely than the former to work in the Education sector (23.1%), the Civil Service (11.5%) and the Community & Social Services (7.3%). (chart 7 & 8)

#### 2.3 Employment Sector by Curriculum

Despite the overall dominance of the commercial sector in the employment of the 1992 graduates, the Education sector has absorbed a significant output of graduates from the following curricula :

B. Sc.	33.7%

Similarly, 44% of the Civil & Structural Engineering graduates and 25% of the Surveying graduates chose to join the Civil Service as Graduate Trainees.

As for the graduates employed in the Community & Social Services, the majority of them came from the curricula in Speech & Hearing (80%) and Social Work (34.8%). (chart 9)

#### 2.4 Trend Analysis

Compared with 1991, there was a significant growth in the percentage of graduates joining the private sector (65.8% to 68.5%) and the Civil Service (6.4% to 9.4%). While the Community and Social Services remained small in the employment of graduates, the Education sector experienced a drop of 5.3% from 23% in 1991 to 17.7% in 1992. (chart 6)

This shift in the employment trend is also noticeable from the trend analysis. As shown in chart 5, the private sector has steadily grown since 1983 (46.9%) to 1992 (72.9%). The Education sector, however, has gradually decreased in its attraction for graduates from 38.5% to 17.7% in ten years' time. (chart 5)

### III.3 Occupation

#### 3.1 Overall Distribution by Occupation

Overall, graduates in 1992 were engaged in a wide variety of occupations. The three most common ones are Secondary Education Teacher (12.60%), Marketing/Sales Executive (8.26%) and Personnel/Administrative/Management Executive (5.92%). (Appendix 2)

#### 3.2 Relevance of Study to Job

As regards the graduates from professional disciplines, most were able to embark on career fields that were relevant to their courses of study :

Graduates from Bachelor of Social Work was probably the exception, with only 26.3% working as social workers. (Faculty reports)

Details of the distribution of graduates among occupations by curriculum can be found in Section IV. (Faculty reports)

### III. 4 Income

#### 4.1 The Overall Situation

Compared with 1991, the basic median monthly income increased by 4.3% from \$8,200 to \$8,550. After taking allowances and other bonus into consideration, the gross median monthly income showed a similar level of increase which was still lower than the recent inflation rate of Hong Kong. (Table 12 & 13)

#### 4.2 Income Analysis by Curriculum

A general increase in the gross median monthly income over 1991 was observed for all curricula except the Dental graduates (- 21.1%) and Arts graduates (- 17.1%). Amongst them, graduates from the following curricula enjoyed a significantly higher increase in remuneration :

#### 4.3 Income Analysis by Employment Sector

According to the income analysis by employment sector, the sector offering the highest gross monthly income was the Community & Social Services (\$14,220), followed in turn by Education (\$13,500) and the Civil Service (\$12,895).

Consistent with the previous years, the Commercial sector - the largest graduate recruiter - was the lowest in remuneration with a gross median monthly salary of \$8,775. (chart 12 & 13)

#### 4.4 Trend Analysis

An analysis using the least-squares trend line was performed on the annual data of the basic median monthly salary of the past nine years (see chart 14). While it shows a steadily increasing trend, the basic salaries in 85, 88 and 92 are slightly below the trend line. In 1993, the basic median monthly salary may rise to \$9,585 (+ 12.1%) in 1993. However, it might be affected by other external factors such as Hong Kong's political environment, China's MFN trading status as well as the world economy at large. (chart 14)

### III. 5 Further Studies

#### 5.1 The Overall Situation

This year, 291 graduates (16%) pursued further studies upon graduation. Amongst them, over 90% furthered their studies in local tertiary institutions. The three most common programmes chosen were Postgraduate Certificate in Laws (44.6%), Master of Philosophy (M. Phil.) (31.5%) and Master (Coursework) (13.4%). (Table 16)

#### 5.2 Analysis by Curriculum

Apart from the LL.B. graduates (91.5%) who mostly took the curriculum 'Post-graduate Certificate in Laws' before admission to the practice of Law in Hong Kong, the Science graduates had the highest incidence of further studies (20.7%), followed by the Electrical & Electronic Engineering graduates (14.4%). (Table 2)

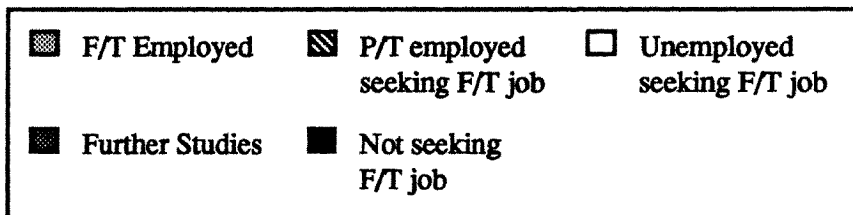
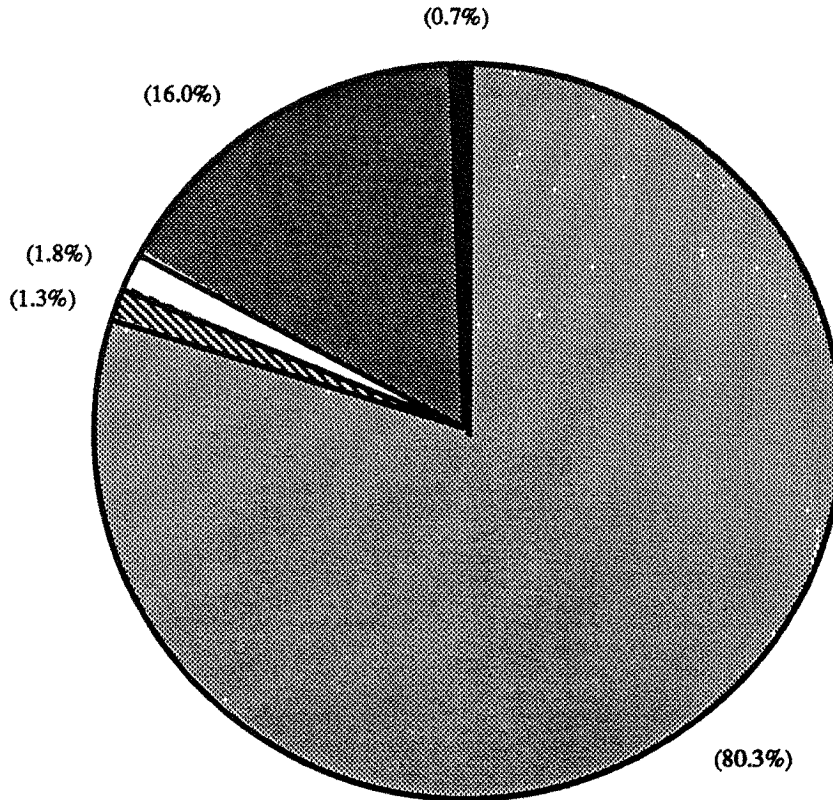


# 1. THE EMPLOYMENT SITUATION OF ALL FIRST-DEGREE RESPONDENTS

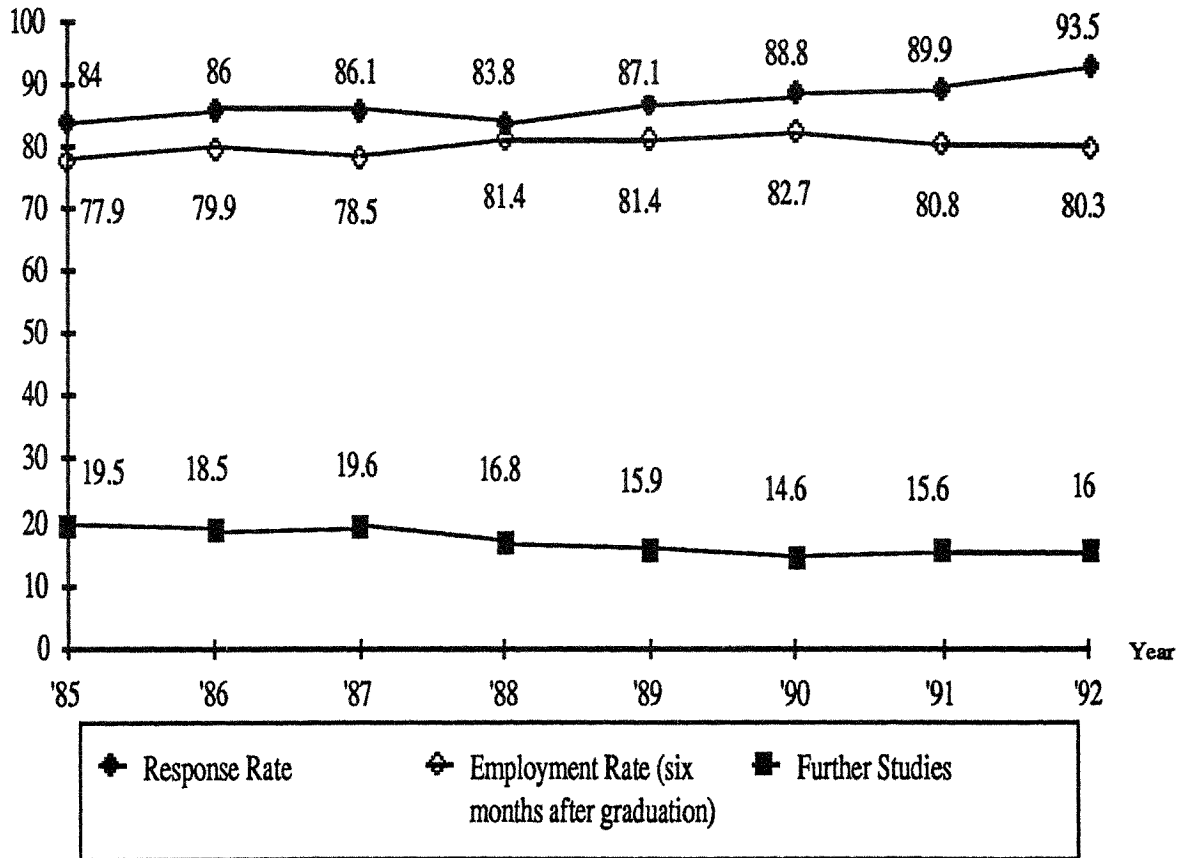

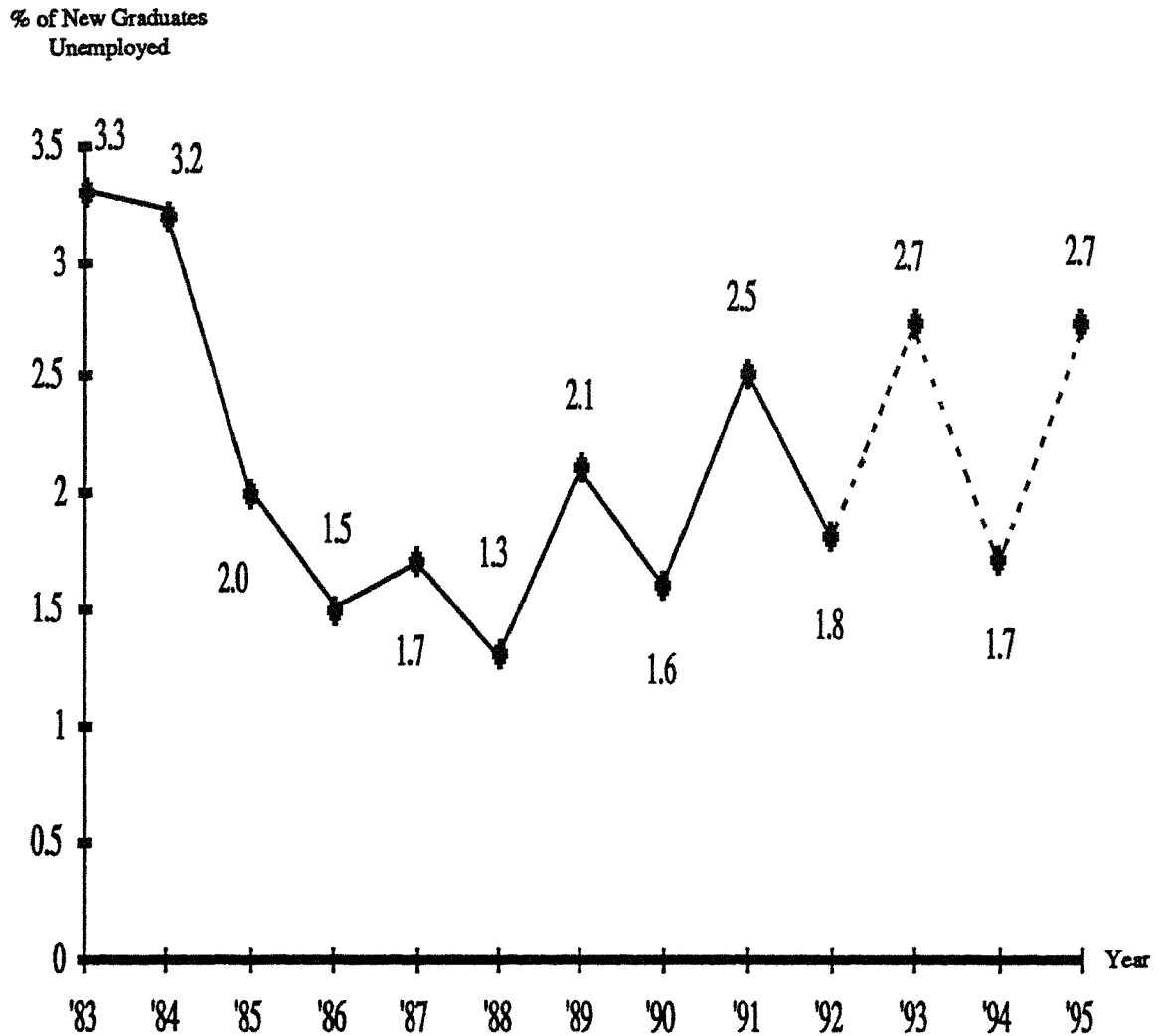

% of New Graduates



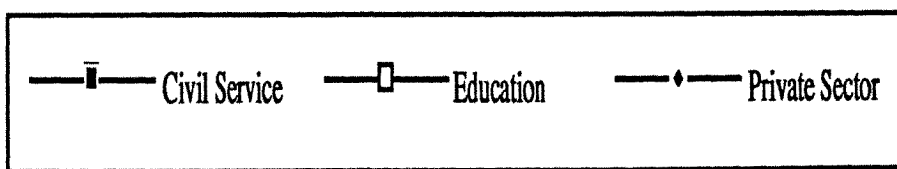
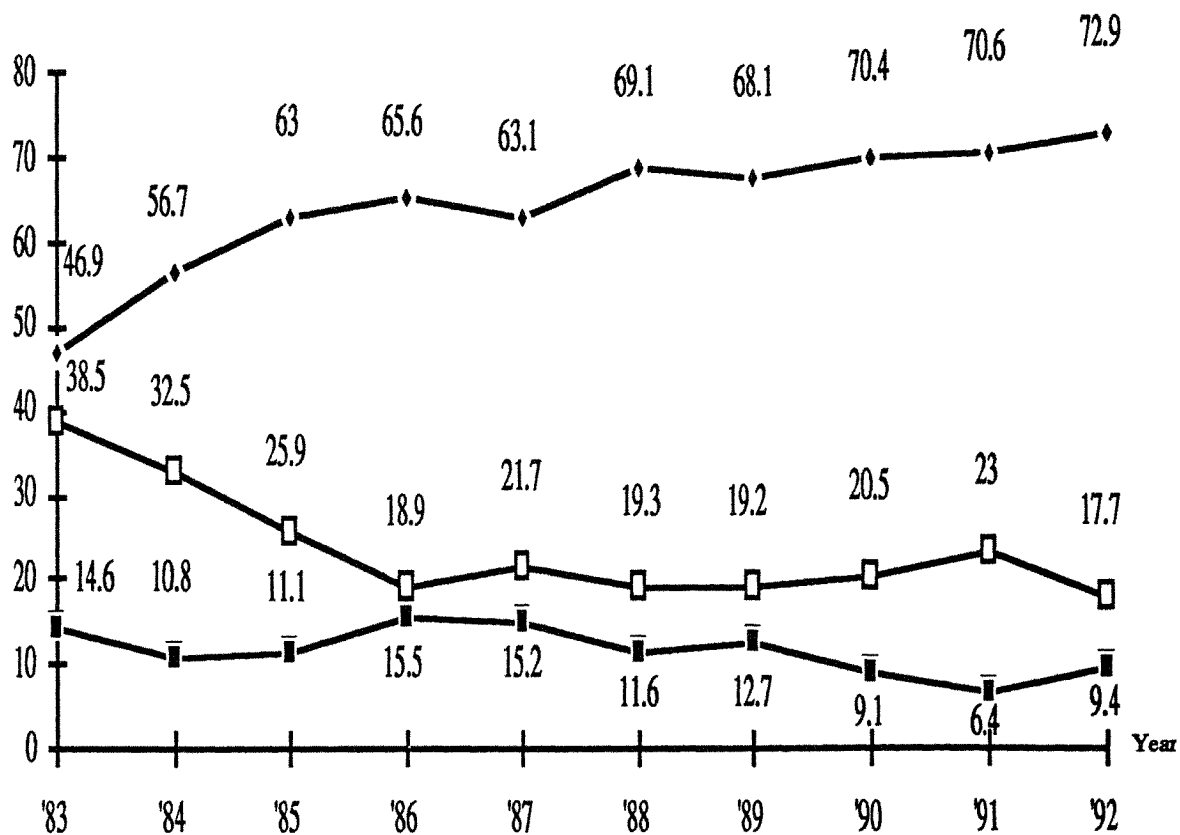
#### 4. THE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE OF NEW GRADUATES (1983 - 1992)

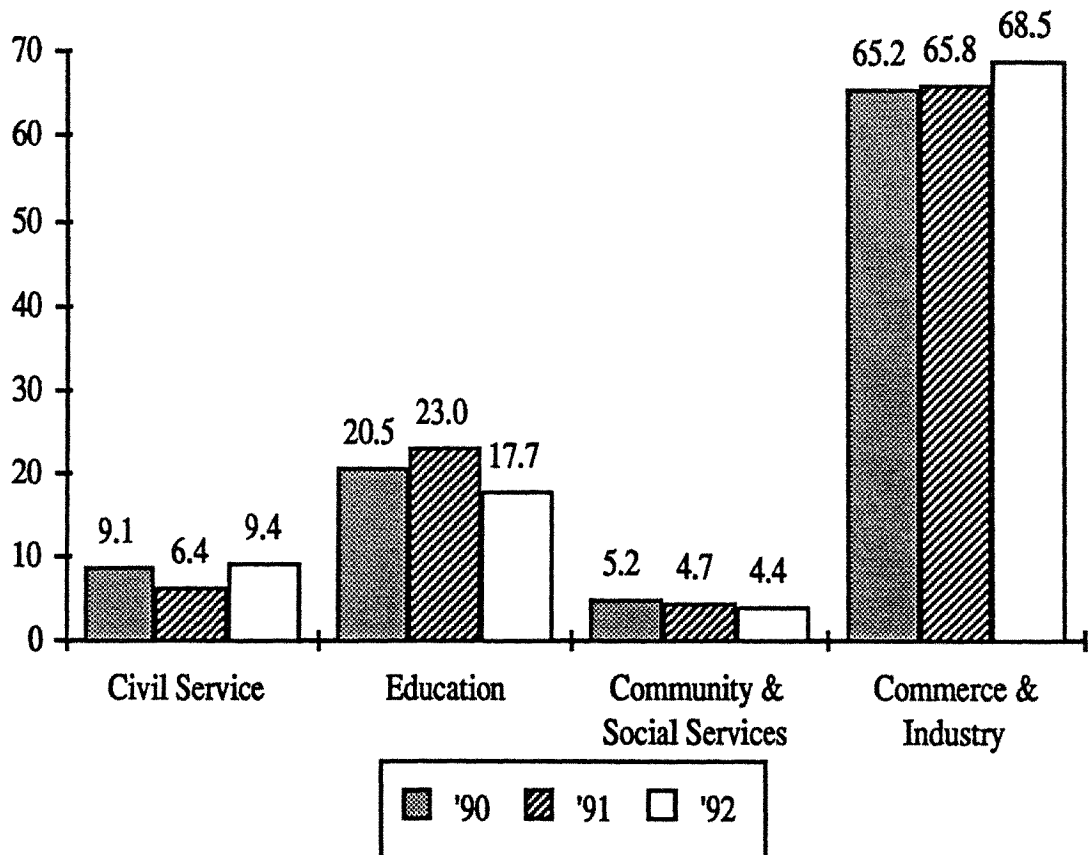
**5. DISTRIBUTION OF THE EMPLOYED GRADUATES IN MAJOR ECONOMIC SECTORS (1983 - 1992)**

% of Employed Graduates



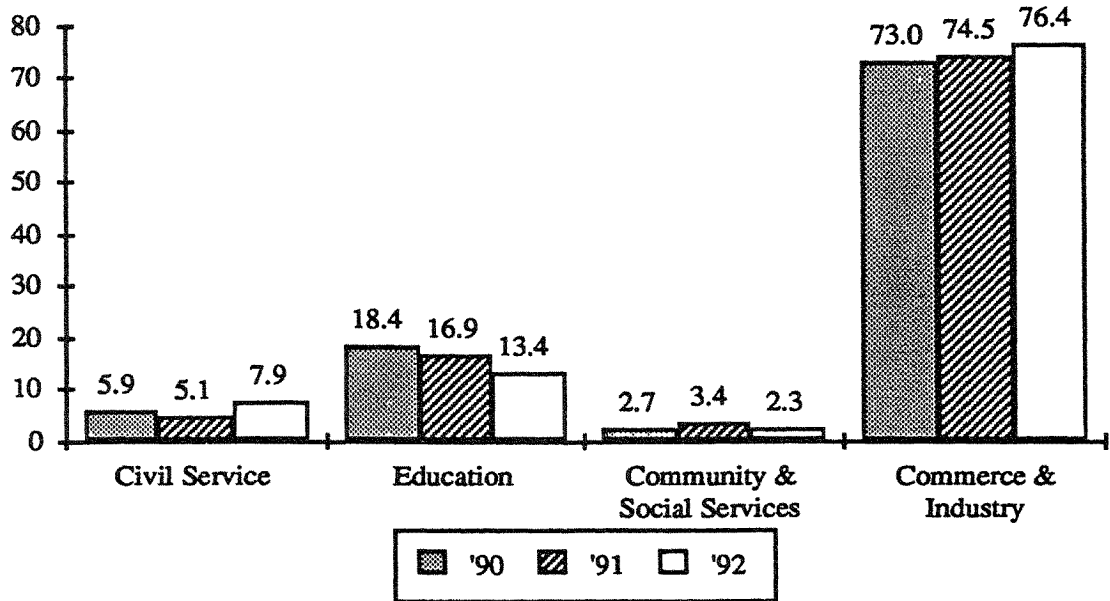
## 6. EMPLOYMENT SECTOR (OVERALL) 1990 - 1992

% of New Graduates



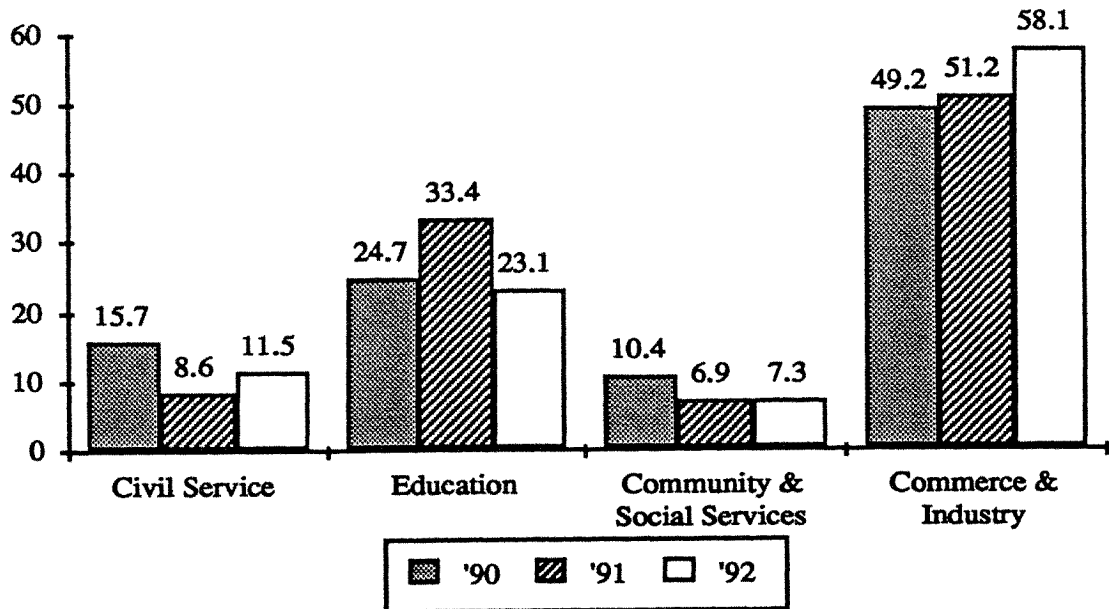
**7. EMPLOYMENT SECTOR (MALE) 1990 - 1992**

% of New Graduates



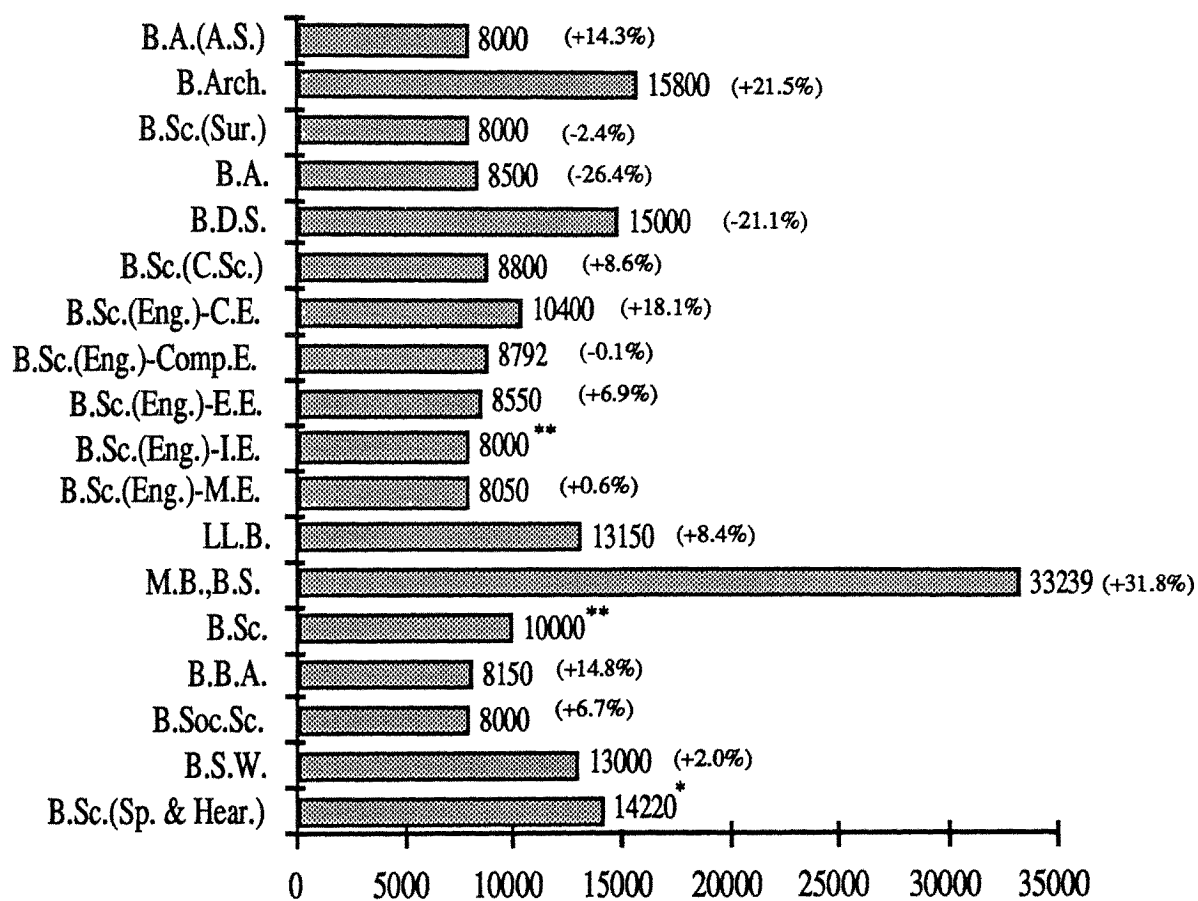

## 10. BASIC MEDIAN MONTHLY SALARY BY QUALIFICATION



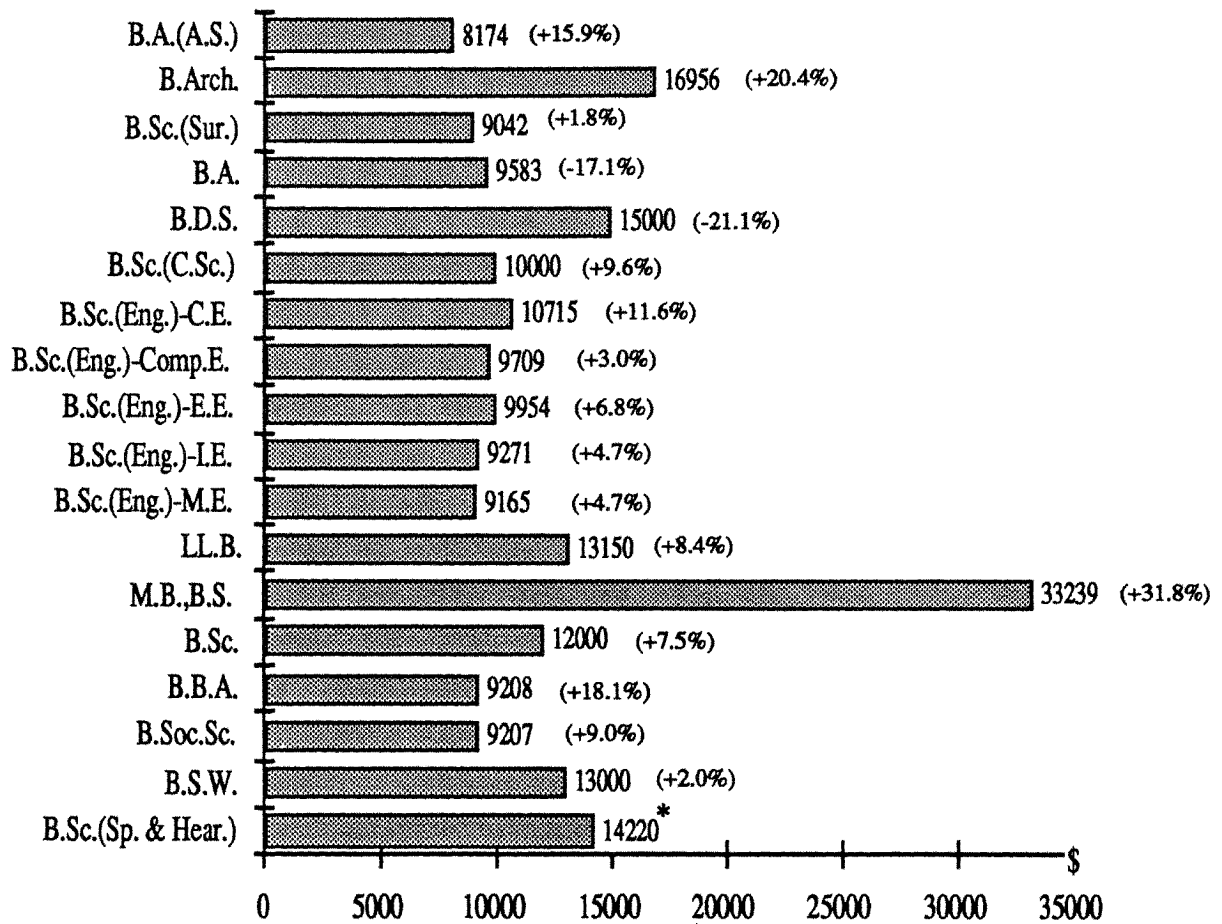
'+' indicates the increasing rate.

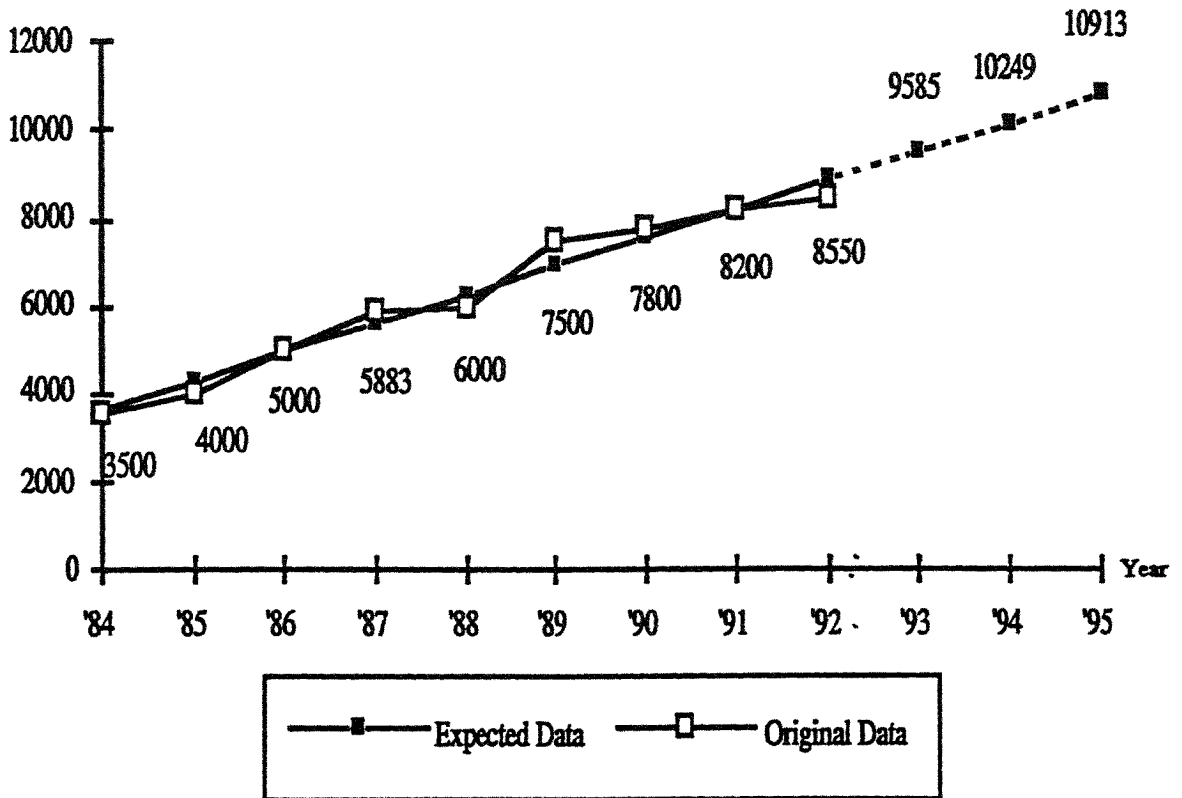

Monthly Salary (HK\$)

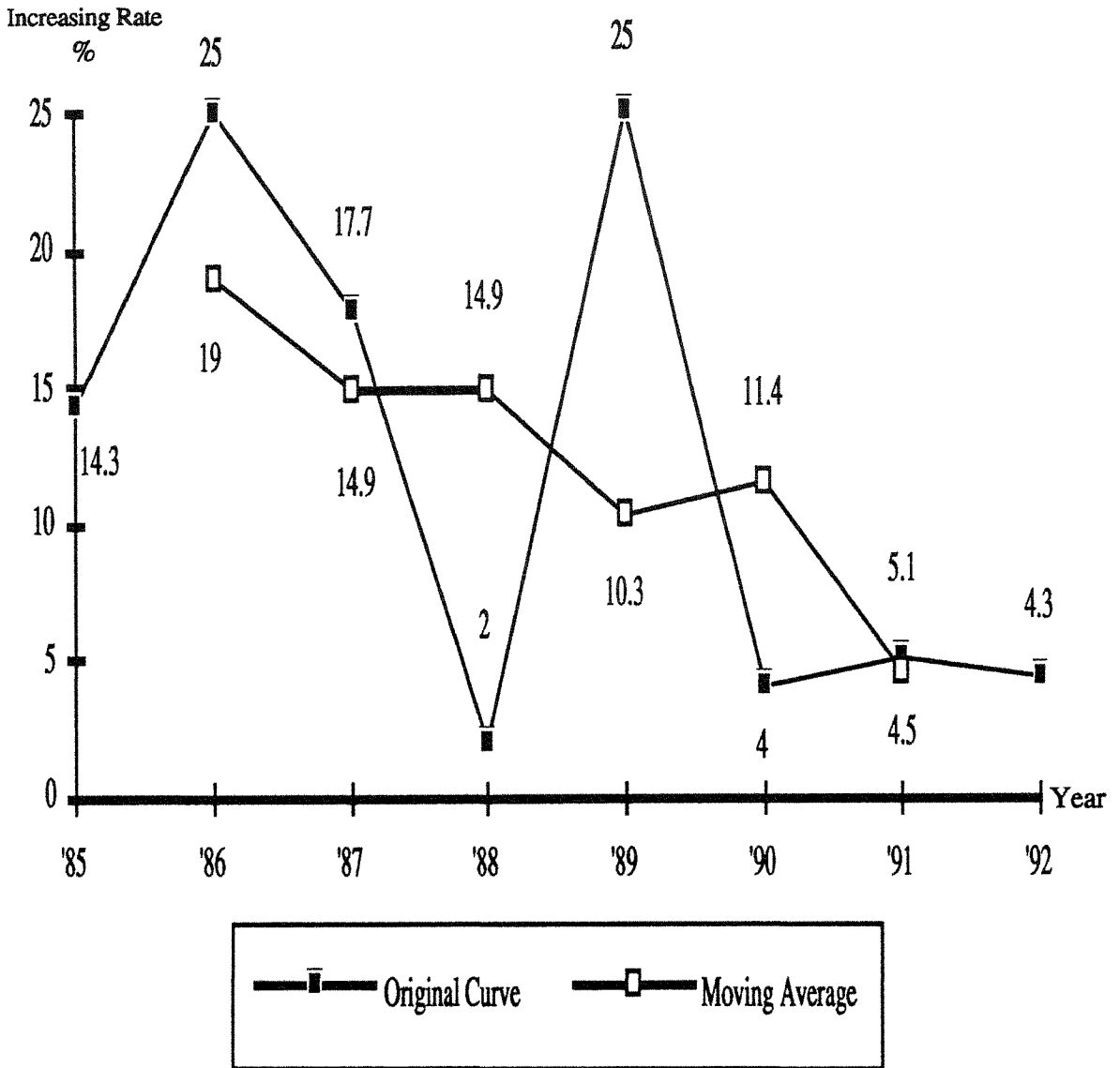


The least-squares trend line  $\hat{y}_i = b_0 + b_1 x_i$  was used to fit the median basic monthly salary of HKU graduates (1984 - 1992). The coded sequence from 1984 to 1992 was selected as -4 -3 -2 -1 0 1 2 3 4.

Fitted Equation :  $y_i = 6,265 + 664x_i$

This equation may be interpreted as follows : The constant indicates that the basic median monthly salary is expected to be HK\$6,265 for the designated origin year - 1988, and the slope  $b_1 = 664$  indicates that the basic median monthly salary is increasing HK\$664 per year.

The length of the period selected for constructing the moving averages is three years. As chart 15 shows, the overall impression of the increasing rate of the basic median monthly salary from 1985 to 1992 shows a tendency to decrease.
